DOE Issues a Reopening of Public Comment Period and Notification of Data Availability Pertaining to Standards for Manufactured Housing

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has issued a <u>pre-publication</u> Federal Register notice of data availability (NODA) for the manufactured housing energy conservation standards rulemaking announcing the availability of updated analyses and results, and is giving interested parties an opportunity to comment on these analyses and submit additional data. DOE is also reopening the public comment period for the supplemental notice of proposed rulemaking (SNOPR) regarding proposals to amend energy conservation standards for manufactured housing. DOE published the SNOPR in the Federal Register on August 26, 2021 and the comment deadline for that SNOPR and this NODA will close on November 26, 2021.

- DOE will accept comments, data, and information regarding this SNOPR and NODA until November 26, 2021. DOE will send a follow-up email once the notice has published in the Federal Register.
